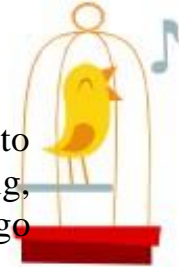


Music

Here are some ideas to help you to have fun with your child at home:

Music all around

Give your child different music experiences. Let them listen to music and different sounds in the environment e.g. birdsong, waves on the beach. Ask them what they can hear when they go for a walk.



Let your child listen to different types of music e.g. classical, pop, world music. Ask them what different instruments they can hear.



Let your child experience different ways of listening to music e.g. a concert, live show, musical theatre, or cd.

Making music

Let your child experiment with making different noises with different instruments and with non musical objects e.g. pots and pans.

Make a musical instrument with your child. You can use old bottles and rice to make a shaker. A paper plate and tin foil to make a tambourine. A small box and elastic bands to make a guitar. Have fun making the instruments and be creative.
