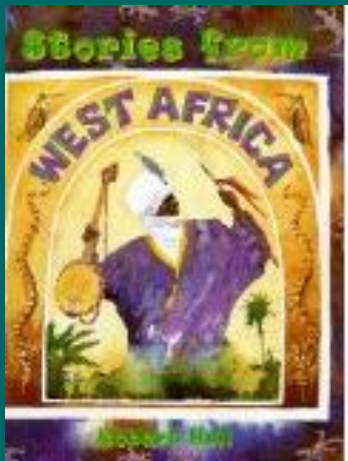


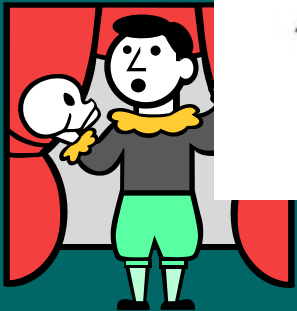

Read in sentences

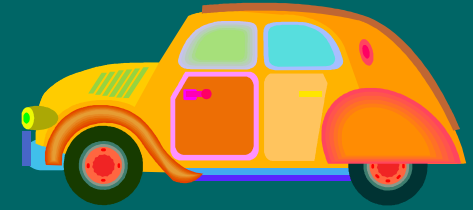
Answer questions about a book

Use the Year Group Guides to help you with ideas to support reading

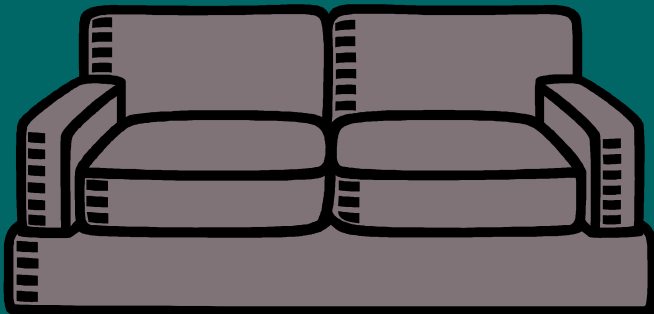
Enjoy Reading Together



Read, Read, Read ...



- It doesn't have to be a story book ... reading is **EVERYWHERE!**
- It doesn't have to be at the kitchen table ... it can happen **ANYWHERE!**
- Keep it interesting, varied and above all **FUN** and **RELAXING** for **EVERYONE.**





Read, Read, Read ...

- Share texts together, especially in the early stages of learning to read.
- The same book again and again is ok ... even when they are getting older.
- Decoding is an important skill but understanding is another key skill.
- Be a role model – read to your child, let them see you become immersed by a story ... get into character!
